Harrow Angling Society

Founded in 1937 our friendly club welcomes all levels of angler, young and old. Harrow Angling Society provides freshwater angling in our private fisheries in Harefield Middlesex in the Colne Valley and in Bucks. The lakes and mature gravel pits contain specimen Carp, Tench, Pike, Bream, Roach, Rudd and Perch.

Society Waters

We offer 4 very different lakes (3 being within the Colne Valley) providing coarse fishing sport to all levels. We also share three quarters of a mile of the river Colne with a weir roughly halfway down the stretch offering good fishing for Chub, Barbel, Perch, etc that can be caught on standard river tactics.

Harefield Pit 1 - A mature gravel pit of around 7 acres situated south of Harefield village. It has two secure car parks located at either end with good footpath access to all Swims. The lake has three Islands and benefits from a good covering of lily pads during the summer months. The Lake is stocked with high quality Carp with fish to 35lbs, there is also an excellent stock of Tench, Bream, Roach and Rudd making this a great all round fishery.

Harefield Pit 2 - A 50 acre gravel pit located in South Harefield. The water is surrounded by good cover. Members can access many swims by car or by walking up to 500 meters from their vehicle, which can be left in one of the 3 car parks around the water.

The lake suffered a complete oxygen crash in August 2017 and at the present time the Society is undertaking a re-stocking programme. The first phase was completed in February 2018 when the last of 165 Carp varying in size between 4lb and 22lb were introduced. The Society is now planning the second phase of the stocking programme which will see the introduction of more species of coarse fish including Roach, Perch, Tench and Bream.

Wildfowl Lake - A place of beauty nestling deep in the Colne Valley between Harefield and Uxbridge. The lake itself is 12 acres with only 10 swims. Roughly triangular in shape and has 2 islands at its base end. Stock wise it's unclear exactly what the lake holds, but confirmed reports of Carp, Pike and Perch will get anglers who are interested in tackling the unknown visiting this lake.

Rowley - Situated just a few miles from Slough this mature 4.5 acre estate lake enjoys a quiet secluded location surrounded by farmland and leafy woodland.

From this mixed fishery the discerning angler can expect to catch Carp to 30lb, Tench and Bream to 7lb, Perch to 3lb and Pike into double figures. The silver fish population is abundant with the odd "goer" Roach and Rudd a possibility. Parking is secure and limited night fishing is allowed. This is very much a fishery for the traditionalist angler, whether you enjoy stalking for carp, float fishing for Tench or lure fishing for Pike and Perch.

River Colne- Harrow Angling Society has negotiated with Yiewsley Angling Society permission to fish their stretch of the River Colne at Iver. The fishery runs South from Iver lane down to the footbridge at Little Britain lake. A small area for car parking can be found in Iver Lane. There is also public parking available at Little Britain lake. The River contains all species of fish including Barbel, Chub, Trout, Tench, Dace, Perch, roach etc and should provide reasonable sport.
